



Let's try to remember the last words of Jesus: I am with you always! When you feel like being unkind to some one, remember the Holy Spirit is with you and will help you be kind. Do you sometimes actually feel Jesus is helping you – do you really feel this power in your heart? Think about it!

### **ACTIVITY**

Let's stand in pairs, two people facing each other. We will remind each other of our Baptism. We don't want to forget. Now each one says to the other one: "You were baptized in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit."

### **CREED**

As we begin to profess our faith this morning, we make the Sign of the Cross together: In the name of the Father....

Do you believe in God the Father who created you? Yes, we believe.  
Do you believe in Jesus who ascended into heaven? Yes, we believe.  
Do you believe in the Holy Spirit who is with us always? Yes, we believe.

### **PETITIONS**

Let's stand in a circle. A circle is a sign of our unity.  
Do you remember what Jesus prayed for the night before He died? (I want all of them to be one with each other, to be united)  
Praying is one of the things that help us be united. So let's pray.
